Council to seek public opinion on Hut's future

An upcoming survey of Tallangatta residents will assist the Towong Shire Council to make a decision about the future of Lord's Hut; currently located on the site of the soon to be constructed Tallangatta Integrated Community Centre.

"It is important for Council to understand how the community feels about the future of Lord's Hut before it is moved to make way for the construction of the Tallangatta Integrated Community Centre," explained Cr Mary Fraser OAM, Towong Shire Council Mayor.

Lord's Hut was originally built in the late 19th century on a property on Yabba Road. It was relocated to the rear of the CEC building in the 1980s. The survey will seek residents' opinions on whether the Hut should be retained in Tallangatta, appropriate relocation costs and options for new sites.

The survey will be distributed to all households by mid-October.
