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Destination Tallangatta - infrastructure works

WHAT IS DESTINATION TALLANGATTA?

Destination Tallangatta is a \$5.3m project, with significant Federal Government funding that delivers the remaining priority projects identified through Tallangatta Tomorrow, including:

- Traffic management and streetscape beautification works in Towong Street
- Lake Hume foreshore improvements
- A new foreshore playground
- Tallangatta Holiday Park upgrade
- Improved pedestrian links between the Rail Trail, main shopping district, residential areas and the Lake Hume foreshore.

INTERSECTION AND POWER INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS:

Road works will commence in early April to upgrade three intersections on Towong Street. The first intersection to be upgraded will be the intersection of Banool Road and Towong Street (at the Memorial Hall). Following this the upgrades to the T-intersections at each end of The Triangles will be constructed. The final design of T-intersections at these location results from extensive design trials and community feedback that were completed in the latter half of 2016.

Electrical works within The Triangles will also begin in April to prepare for the undergrounding of power in the Towong Street CBD. These works will be undertaken later in 2017.

These works are jointly funded by Towong Shire Council (using ratepayer funds) and the Federal Government's National Stronger Regions Fund as part of the Destination Tallangatta project.
