Check your load before heading to the autumn waste collections

Towong Shire residents are encouraged to check that the waste they intend to dispose of at the upcoming hardwaste and greenwaste collections can be safely accepted by Council.

Council's Director Technical Services, Mr Jamie Heritage, said that the disposal of products with gas-related components were of particular concern.

"Old fridges, freezers and air conditioning units that have a gas system are not able to be handled safely with the equipment available at the temporary collection sites," explained Mr Heritage. "We encourage residents to dispose of these items safely at permanent waste disposal sites in Corryong, Tallangatta or Wodonga".

The temporary hardwaste and greenwaste collection sites will be set up at the following locations in April and May:

- **Yabba Road**, Saturday 11 April 2015, 10am - 1pm
- **Bellbridge**, Sunday 12 April 2015, 10am - 1pm
- **Mitta Mitta**, Saturday 18 April 2015, 10am - 1pm
- **Dartmouth**, Sunday 19 April 2015, 10am - 1pm
- **Cudgewa/Tintaldra**, Saturday 2 May 2015, 10am - 1pm
- **Walwa**, Sunday 3 May 2015, 10am - 1pm

Further collections will be held at other sites during October.

Residents can dispose of their bulky waste free of charge by presenting their waste disposal vouchers, issued with rates notices, at the upcoming collections or at the waste disposal facilities in Corryong, Tallangatta or Wodonga. Up to one cubic metre, equivalent to a 6x4 trailer, can be disposed of at no cost with each voucher.
