Works underway at Tennis Courts

Works have started on the \$166,000 Corryong Tennis Court upgrade project, following the appointment of specialist contractor Riverina Sporting Services.

“Council staff have been focused on ensuring that we engaged quality contractors to give the best results possible for the Corryong community,” explained Towong Shire Council Mayor, Cr David Wortmann

“With Riverina Sporting Services being engaged to undertake the works, we are expecting that the tennis courts will be ready to be used this summer.” said Cr Wortmann.

Funding from the project was provided by a number of partners, with \$40,000 being provided by Towong Shire Council, \$7,000 from the Corryong Recreation Reserve Committee and a further \$16,000 from the Corryong Tennis Club. These funds were then used to leverage \$100,000 of funding from the State Government, through the Community Facility Funding Program.

“This is another great example of Council partnering with local clubs and groups to deliver an outcome that will benefit the community.” said Cr Wortmann.
