

Towong Street Upgrade Stage 2

What is happening?

Laying of black concrete “thresholds” at the entry to each building, renewal of concrete between the front of the buildings and the kerb, new kerb outstands, street furniture, landscaping, and paving, new kerb and guttering and removal of overhead powerlines.

When will the works begin?

Works will commence late February 2018.

How long will the works take?

The street works are expected to take approximately six months to complete, depending on weather and other potential disruptions.

Removal of overhead power lines requires complex negotiations with building owners, power suppliers, Ausnet and contractors, and may take longer.

Will any shops be closed during the works?

Towong Street shops are expected to remain open throughout the works. Council and its contractors will make every effort to minimise disruption to businesses. Only if an unexpected complication occurs will a shop need to consider closing for a short period. Some shop owners may decide to reduce hours or close for short periods during some stages of the works.

Will the street be closed during works?

Towong Street will be open to through traffic at all times during the works.

Will parking be affected?

Sections of parking may be affected at times during the works. Alternative parking will be available on the other side of Towong Street, on the north side of Triangles Park and in side streets.

Where can I look at the design for the street upgrade?
